USBR Technical Workshop: Two Decades of District Modernization

Thursday (January 20, 2022) 4:00-5:30pm (time approximate). ITRC will renew water district training opportunities in San Luis Obispo in February 2022. Speakers include Jarret Martin, GM Central California Irrigation District (Modernization of CCID reservoirs, SCADA sites, and flow measurement options); Bill Stretch, GM Fresno Irrigation District (Improvements including pipeline replacement, conversion to automated gate valves, adding over 100 long crested weirs, adding over 100 SCADA sites, 800-acres of recharge basins) and Bert Bryan, GM of Walker River Irrigation District (Management of a \$10 million program to update river diversions in the Walker River basin including new automated gates, new flumes, several long-crested weirs and miles of pipeline replacement). 
9th Annual Silent Auction benefiting the Mid-Pacific Water Users' Conference Scholarship
